

General Fire Safety

Course Description: This fire-safety course addresses OSHA's general industry standards for fire safety and emergency evacuation (Subpart E, 29CFR1910.36, 37, and 38). It shows students know the standards relate to exit routes, emergency evacuation plans, and required fire-suppression systems. Also included is a poster that describes what is meant by the acronyms <RACE> and <PASS>.

Course Objectives:

- Describe the importance of having a fire safety and evacuation plan
- Define the standards for a fire safety and evacuation plan, along with exit routes
- Describe how to use a fire extinguisher based on the <PASS> acronym
- Describe what is meant by the <RACE> acronym
- Differentiate between classes of fires and appropriate types of fire extinguishers
